A Bill for appointing Rangers for y^e Defense of this Province, Read y^e second and third tymes and assented to by y^e House.

A Bill imposing a Duty of ten p^{er} cent upon all European Goods exported out of this Province: Read the second and third tymes and assented to by y^e House.

A Bill for Appeals and Regulating Mitts of Snow, Read the second and third tymes and assented to by y^e House.

A Bill for the Naturalization of Merchants Clerks and others, Read the second and third tyme and assented to by y^e House.

A Bill for Reviving the temporary Laws of this Province. Read and assented to by y^e House.
