

Since His Anivall, and Recommended to them that as they were most of them Magistrates in their severall Counties, that they would duly observe them and the other good Laws of this Province and all Ordinances made this Year, as also that they would be the same duly observed and put in execution without which their Labour and pains in making them would prove altogether vain and useles.

Further His Ex^{ty} Recommended to them that they would signifie to the Inhabitants of their severall Counties, that they should not be disheartened or discouraged through the Rumour and Noise of heavy taxes, and to persuade them from their folly and unadvisedness in leaving the Country upon such idle Rumours and Stories.

Then His Ex^{ty} told them that he prorogued them untill the 20th of March ensuing - and in Case there should be no occasion of their Meeting at that tyme, he would give them notice thereof in Feb^{ry} next and further prorogue them.
