 this day brought to ye House in Answer to our Message yesterday sent
 to your Board in Relation to ye Order of Councill affixed at ye
 Door of the House of Assembly we find the same no ways satisfac-
 tory - to our Desire and Message - w^t - that ye said Order may not
 stand on ye Journall of ye Hon^{ble} Councill - therefore humbly presume
 to press ye Game again to Govt- Exce^r and His Maj^y Hon^{ble} Councill -
 that it may be taken otherwise, this House will adjourn to some other
 place and proceed to no other busines until such time as we shall
 receive a Satisfactory Answer thereto -
