This House do wonder and are much agrieved at the unparliamentary
proceedings and renewall of ye breach of our priviledges
By His Maj^{ty} Hon^{ble} Councille who instead of affording us the
Reasonable Satisfaction of this House desired ye Board should
further proceed to Infringe our priviledges by Requiring to know
what Members were present or absent when this House rose
Upon sending ye Message this Day by Major Hamonds and
other Members of this House, Yet for Satisfaction of ye Hon^{ble}
Board. We acquaint you the same was Resolved Nemine
Contradicente, therefore once more humbly desire some satisfactory
Answer to our former Message upon which we shall readily proceed
to such business as His Exc^{ty} shall propose for His Maj^{ty} Service
and the Wellfare of this Province.
