Resolved by ye House that ye Lawes therunto Relating are all sufficient. That as to Runaway Serv^t Debtors &c to Virginia &c that a Law or some proposall pass to be sent to Virginia to effect ye same.

Resolved that proposalls be made to Virginia for a Conditionall act to be passed here and in that Colony in relation to such Runaways.

That care be taken about laying ye publique Levy seeing that for ye future it will not be permitted to be left to ye Management of a private Committee.

Resolved that ye same be not layde during the sitting of this House - the House will make provision therefore.

That ye toleration such Liberty as is taken by priests may prove a discom-
agement to my Lord Bishop of London to send in Ministers among us -
therefore is particularly urged and recommended.

Resolved by ye House that ye Romish priests within this Province complying with ye Lawes thereof be suffered to marry such persons as shall apply themselves unto them therefore.

That an act be made straightly enjoining ye severall and respective Sheriffs of ye severall Counties within this Province to give notice to ye severall Inhabitants of their Counties to appear at ye Election of Burgesses, or Representatives of ye said County or otherwise to send their voted Yeales up to ye Sheriffs by them to be broken open at ye Election.

Resolved that ye Lawes have already sufficiently provided therefore.

Resolved that ye thanks of ye House be returned Mr. Penne Coneys for his thanksgiving Sermon preached on Thursday last being the day sett apart for a Solemn thanksgiving for his (Maj^{ty}) success and safe arrival.

That whereas Mr. Anthony Workeman of Kent Islands intends to build an house of the value of an 100th Sterl. and hath obligd himself upon his oath to leave ye same to ye use of Free Schools - proposed that a Law be made to confirm ye free Simple of ye Land - - - of Workeman wherein he intends to build ye afo^{re} house.

Resolved that a short bill be prepared for that purpose.

That an act be made for Appeals from the Court of Probate of Wills &c to be heard before his Ex^{ty} the Gov^{or} & Councill.

Resolved that ye Lawes have already sufficiently provided for Appeals from ye said Court.

That ye severall publique Roads within this Province be ascertaind, widened and Marked, and that ye Com^{rs} of ye severall Counties see ye same be Cleared and Repaired yearly.

Resolved that the act of Assembly appointing Overseers of the Highways hath sufficiently provided therefore.

That ye said Roads be recorded in ye Secretaries Office.
