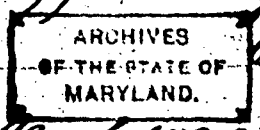

The said Proposals being read were all approved off. Respect being had to the value of the Negro Eighty buche Skins being thought too little, but left to the discretion of the persons appointed to treat with them.

And thereupon Resolved, that the Hon<sup>ble</sup> Colonel Addison, Thomas Brooke and Thomas Terrell Esq. Gent. of his Matys Hon<sup>ble</sup> Councille, Major Smallwood, Major Baston, Wm. Hutchison, Wm. John Hawkins Wm. Jnr White and Capt. Phillip Hoffkins goe immediately to the Piscataway and Archaicke Indians upon the Treaty of<sup>d</sup> and that Henry Moore goes their Interpreter.

Ordered that Wm. Perry the post be sent with a Copy of these proposals to his Excell<sup>ty</sup> J<sup>no</sup> Edmond Androp his Matys Gov. of Virginia.

As to the Chaptice and Nanticoke Indians this Excell<sup>ty</sup> is pleased to say they need <sup>not</sup> come here for that God willing he will be there this Summer.

Resolved that Major Thompson and Mr. Vanderheydon of Beed County, Wm. Boothby and Col. Marke Richardson of Battemore County be sent to the Indians at the head of the Bay to give them Caution either to call in yr Mountain Indians or to acquaint them that we expect they should be answerable for them if any Injuries happen to be done as also to acquaint them what Measures we have taken with the Piscataway Indians.

This Excell<sup>ty</sup> is pleased to declare that he never tooke any presents of the Indians, but what he rather gave them more in value, and that he never tooke what was offered him but only one Skin of a Gorte.

Ordered that Capt. Hans Tillman bring downe the Indians at ye head of ye Bay to ye Gov. and Councille at the next provinciale Court, being accordingly sworne Interpretes.

The said Hans Tillman is also ordered to go along with the Gents to the Indians at ye head of the Bay.

Ordered that the 2 Capt<sup>ns</sup> of the Ranges, each have ten Grammes ten ffuses, two Spades, two pickaxes and two shovells delivered to them, and that the Colonells of Prince Georges and Battemore Counties deliver to them Cris. each, Capt. Bristwell and Chen 50<sup>th</sup> of powder with flint and Ball equivalent the Game to be returned backe and not made use of but upon action.

Mr. Speaker and ye Rest of the Mem<sup>bers</sup> take leave of this Excell<sup>ty</sup> and repaire again to the house where Mr. Speaker having taken ye Chair.

Adjourned the house till 6 of the Clock tomorrow Morning.
