 Sent by Mr. Haley and Mr. Young, who returned and say they have  
 delivered their Message.

A protested Bill of Exch. due from the County drawn by Mr. Samuel  
 Cooksey War<sup>o</sup> Officer of Potomack upon Cap<sup>t</sup>. Peter Puzgen payable to Mr.  
 James Dowling of St. Marys County being considered by the house, Resolved  
 the said Bill and the damage of the protest be paid Mr. Ben. Hall who  
 is intermarried with the said Mr. Bowling's Executrix by the Publick <sup>and</sup>  
 Treasurer of the Western Shore.

His <sup>Prof.</sup> the Governour having acquainted the house that it was  
 wished a Method of holding the Assemblies might be ascertained.

The house taking the same into consideration do Unanimously  
 resolve that they will draw up no Methods of holding Assemblies, but  
 continue in the forme they have done, but as they shall gain Experience  
 will endeavour to come nearer and nearer to the practice of the  
 Parliament in England as the Constitution of this Province will admit.

The Report of the Committee of Grievances taken into further Consideration.  
 It being by the said Committee Reported. That they have considered  
 it as a great Grievance been sued att his Maty's suite upon Navigation  
 and County Bonds but no person nominated att whose request such  
 action or suite was commenced. So that many times in case of dismiss-  
 ion of such action <sup>of</sup> Debt is left with out remedy for Costs.

Therefore for the future the Committee pray that some Rule or Ordina-  
 nce may be made that no such action be brought unless the writt be  
 first endorsed att whose request the same issues, so that the persons  
 Debt<sup>s</sup> may apply themselves for agreement or other wise be provided to  
 make their defenses.

Referred to the Committee of Laws to draw up an explanatory  
 Ordinance thereof.
