And therefore thinks it convenient for his Majesty's Service to ~~the~~ Prorogue them till the Twenty Eight of this Instant.

And that the House are hereby prorogued.

Mr Speaker and the House repair to the State House and Mr Speaker having taken the Chair.

Prorogues this House till the 28th Instant.

And the House thereupon prorogued accordingly.
