Resolved that it be referred to the Committee of Laws to Consider thereof Major John Hammond and Mr. Thomas Staley and Mr. Sam^l. Young are sent with the Answer to his Ex^{ty}. Propositions.

Read John Newtons Petition.

Ordered that he be allowed 20^s of Tobacco a Day for his Accomodation during this Session of Assembly.

Read Mr. Lydalls Petition. Ordered that he be allowed for so long time as he kept the Ferry.

Mr. Eliza Hall and Mr. Walter Lane Came from the Committee of Grievances and required of Mr. Speaker the Journals of the last Committee of Grievances which he had the last Session.

Who makes answer that his Ex^{ty} in his Mat^{ty}. Name Comanded him to deliver it up before he went out of Towne.

Ordered that Mr. Francis Jenkins, Mr. Mich^l. Miller, Mr. James Crauford, Mr. John Cavile, Col. Minian Beale, Mr. Simon Millmar and Mr. Rich^d. Tilghman be appointed a Committee of Laws.
