Ordered that Maj. Tho. Smith, Col. John Thompson, Mr. Sam^l. Young, Capt. Philip Hoskins, Mr. James Smallwood, Col. Minian Beale and Mr. Wm. Hutchison be appointed a Committee to confer with his Maty's Hon^{ble}. Council in relation to the Indian affairs.

By the House of Delegates July 4th 1699.

This House have appointed Maj. Tho. Smith, Col. John Thompson, Mr. Sam^l. Young, Mr. Philip Hoskins, Mr. James Smallwood, Col. Minian Beale, and Mr. Wm. Hutchison to joine in conference with his Maty's Hon^{ble}. Council in relation to the affairs concerning the Indians and to attend them at such time and place as they shall appoint.

Sis Mercury July 5th 1699. The House met againe, and were present as yesterday - Read over what was done yesterday and on Monday.

The Committee appointed to consider of the Indian affairs, Enter the House and Report as follows.

By the Committee appointed to confer with some of his Maty's Honble Council of Affairs relating to the Indians &c. July 5. 1699.

The Committee having taken into their serious Consideration the affair relating to the Indians they think it necessary and convenient that Major James Smallwood and Mr. Wm. Hutchison be dispatched with all convenient speed to go to the Pamunkie Indians that are lately come in from the Pisecatway Indians under pretence to say to know whether they will abide or settle there or are returned back againe to the Pisecatways and if not returned back to see and endeavour to persuade some of the Great men of the said Indians to appear before his Ex^{ty} the Gov^{er}. and his Maty's Honble Council and the Honble the House of Delegates and Deputys now sitting in Assembly to know whether they will come in and remain amongst us.

And further the said Committee doe say they cannot proceed any further in the said affair relating to the Indians until the returne of the said Messengers.
