Proposed that for as much as in the acc^t of Maj. Wm. Whittington when he was Treasurers of the Eastern Shore there was a mistake for that he had paid to the Publick a certain Sum of Money which was raised by the act of Assembly upon ffurres &c. and which was not due to the Publick but to the free Schoole.

Ordered that the said acc^t be inspected and if such Mistake be found that it be rectified and if Money applied to the right use.
