 read the third time.

A Bill for Impowering Benj^a. Williams and his heirs to sell the Lands
 of Joseph Williams his Brother deceased called Tiboulds for the paymt^t
 of the Debts of the Said Joseph Williams, read the third time.

Proposed that an address be Drawne up to send to his Magt^r to
 pray his Maty^{ys} Clemencye in relieving of th severall Judgments given
 in this Province ag^t severall the Inhabitants of this Province upon
 Navigation Bonds.

Resolved that an address be drawne up and that the Committee
 of Lawes prepare such an address.
