Read over what was done on Saturday. Read Mr. Banjeeungs Pet^t praying an Act to pass to sell the Lands of M^r. Sam^t. Mithers and M^r. John Lewellin decd: to pay the Debts of the said Mithers and Lewellin.

Referred to a further Consideration.

A Bill for Transferring the Debts in Queen^t County due from the late officers by virtue of the Act of Assembly imposing a Mailt upon officers read the third time.

A Bill for Improving Benj^a Williams and his Heirs to sell the Lands of Joseph Williams his Brother deceased called Tibauds for the payment of the Debts of the said Joseph Williams, read the third time.

Resolved that an address be Drawne up to send to His Maj^t to pray his Maj^t Clemency in Relieving of y^e Several Judgments given in this Province ag^t Several the Inhabitants of this Province upon Navigation Bonds.

Resolved that an address be drawne up and that the Committee of Laws prepare such an address.
