We have Called Coll: W^m Pence before us and doe find that he has
rec^d of Summe of Two thousand five hundred fifty six pounds of Tobacco
the which he is to be accountable for to y^e Publick as all soe his fine
according to the asp^d Order of the house and all soe promised to Refund the
3/4 of a pound of Tobacco & sell which he unjustly Levied to the County.

The house adjourns till to Morrow Six of Clock.

from this house towards the defraying the Charge of Transporting
herself and family back to England. It is Resolved by this house that
the said Mary Fielder should be allowed out of the publick Charge
of this province twenty pounds Sterl: if Your Exc^t and Council
shall be pleased to Concurr therewith.
