and value the same by a Jury according to the act of Assembly made and
provided for purchasing of fifty acres of Land at the said Coole Springs.

The House adjourned till to Morrow Morning five of Clock.

Courts read the second time.

Read Maj^r W^m Dents petition praying an allowance for his
attendance on his Ex^{ty} and Council as Att^r Gen^l.

Put to the vote if he shall be allowed his Expenses or not.
And Carried in the Negative.

Upon the Reading of the Message Concerning the Rangers.

Resolved that the same be referred to the Committee to Consider of
Indian Affairs, and Ordered that a Message be sent to his Ex^{ty} and
Council in Relation thereto.
