

The Honble James Fairby Esq^r and (Maj^r John Hammonds, Entered the House and presented the following Message in Relation to passing an Act for Regulating Maniagers and a Letter from Mr. Rich^d Sewell in Relation to the same.

Ordered that the same be referred to the Committee of Laws.

Proposed by a Member of this House whether the three pence paid since his present Esq^r accession to this Govern^t does now by any Law belong to this present Gov^t - if not that a Bill be prepared to insert it in him.

Resolved that a Bill be prepared to Invest the three pence paid in his present Esq^r Nathaniel Blackstone that has accrued since his Esq^r has taken this Government upon him.

This House have received the Message this day sent by the Honble James Fairby and Major John Hammond and have considered the same, and humbly desire that his (Maj^r Wm^o Gen^l) may prepare a Bill thereon and present the same to the Consideration of this House.
