The Committee having read the Return of the Sheriff of St. Marys County
the writ for Election of one Delegate to serve for the said County and
likewise have heard Complaints of the Delegates and some of the
Inhabitants of the said County that there was an Election of John
Nuttwell and that the said Election was made at a remote place
from the County Court house a place of no resort but a neck of land
all together out of the way and that many of the Electors in the Incident
named are not qualified by Law to make such Election and likewise
it is presumed that there was not a Court there held for keeping the
Kings peace for that at the same time there was fighting and Riots
and accidents committed that the people of the County could not have their
votes free as of their Complaints. we have received two Members of the
said County and some other Inhabitants of the same being not able at
Present to Inform the Truth thereof doe pray that such proofs may be
suspended till the Next Assembly.

And wee the said Committee being tender of our Privilege doe on behalf
of the said Delegates and Inhabitants of the said County pray that the
whole Matter herein contained may be further Enquired into by the
next Genl. Assembly and that the truth may be fully inquired into
Publick Notice may be given to the Inhabitants of the said County that
they may then be heard.

All which wee refer to the Consideration of the House of
Delegates.
