the House bought of Maj: Edw Dorsey Enters the House and Reports as followeth viz.

- (1) They find it absolutely Necessary for the preservation of the House that the Sillers be filled up.
- (2) That the plank floor over the Sillers be taken up and there be new Sleepers and the floor new layd.
- (3) That one of the windows in that room be Close made up the others to have folding Shuttles with plank and hung with hinges.
- (4) In the other room two windows and a Loft door Close made up folding Shuttles with plank hung with hinges as in the other rooms for one other window the outward floor levelled.
- (5) one new Ground Jill be putt in at the outward door of the room.
- (6) one small breach in the breast of the Chimney to be made good for the safety of the house and all other breaches in the said house belonging to Carpenters workes to be made good the Doors well hung Close fitted with a Good stock Lock and Key.
- (7) all which will be undertaken to be done by Mr: Beard of this Towne for ten pounds in Money which we with Submission to the House think it may be reasonably worth.

Which was here read and Mr: Rich: Beard being desired to walk into the house he appeared and being demanded if he will undertake the workes in the report mentioned for 12 ^S Ster: which the said Mr: Beard very willingly accepted thereof and obliged himself to finish the said workes by the last day of Aug: next.

Ordered that Messrs be prepared and sent his next to concur thereto.

The House adjourned till to Morrow (Morning at 7 a Clock).
