

The petition of Mr. Phill. Lynes for an allowance of acres of publick  
acc<sup>ts</sup>. Recommended by his Ex<sup>ty</sup>. the Gov<sup>o</sup> and Councill last Assembly to the  
House of Delegates, was here read and Resolved the same be referred to Mr.  
Mr. Harris Coll<sup>o</sup>. Tho<sup>s</sup> Ennalls and Major Thomas Smith to examine into  
and inspect his acct and Claims and Report here to morrow Morning  
their proceeding thereupon that the said Lynes may have Right done.

Which Committee being sent out at the prayer of the said Lynes.  
Therefore the said Lynes came and in the House Obliged himself to be  
concluded and abide by the Report of the said Committee, and upon such report  
is never more to make any further Claims.

In all which the said Lynes did readily Concurr.  
Thomas Tench and John Addison Esq<sup>r</sup>. Enters the house and delivers the  
Speakers Message the Consideration whereof is referred till to morrow  
Coll<sup>o</sup>. Tho<sup>s</sup> Ennalls Enters the house and delivers Mr. Speaker the  
following Ordinance which was Ordered to be read.

Whereas the boundes of the Land formerly Granted unto Ababeco had  
Swamp and Tilkivaton the Choptank Indians by act of assembly, was  
never run out and Ascertained by means whereof severall Differences  
have arisen between the said Indians and English touching the same  
and it was thereon Ordered that Lieut. Coll<sup>o</sup>. Tho<sup>s</sup> Ennalls the Kings  
Sur<sup>o</sup> of Dorchester County doe survey the said Lands according to Metts  
and boundes in the said Act sett Downe.

And that Lieut. Coll<sup>o</sup>. Smithson of Talbot County Coll<sup>o</sup>. Charles Hutchins  
Mr. Jacob Loeckeman Mr. Tho<sup>s</sup> Hicks and Mr. W<sup>m</sup>. Mifflin of Dorches-  
ter County was appointed and empowered to see and Direct the  
Sur<sup>o</sup> in running of the same and make Report thereof to the next  
assembly. in some short time after Coll<sup>o</sup>. Charles Hutchins Deceased  
this Life by which reason the said Order was not Complied with.

Wherefore it is Ordered and Ordained by this Gen<sup>l</sup>. Assembly and  
the Authority of the same that those persons hereafter Named viz<sup>t</sup>.

The honorable Coll<sup>o</sup>. Thomas Smithson, Major Jacob Loeckeman,  
Mr. Tho<sup>s</sup> Hicks, Mr. John Leconit, Mr. W<sup>m</sup>. Mifflin Mr. Hugh Reclston  
and Capt. Henry Ennalls or the Major part of them are hereby  
Authorized and Empowered to direct the said Thomas Ennalls Sur<sup>o</sup>  
as afo<sup>r</sup> to Survey and lay out the said Indian Lands, according to  
the former Ordinance of assembly and that the said Sur<sup>o</sup> a Cert.  
and faire plott with all convenient Speed returne to his Ex<sup>ty</sup> the  
Gov<sup>o</sup> and Councill.
