This house Concives that Capt Rich<sup>t</sup>. Hill had formerly lett the house in the petition mentioned to the County for a publick store, for powder till they were better provided.

Therefore resolved that the publick powder be still lodged there, till the County shall be better provided with a more convenient place for that purpose.
