They returne and say they delivered the same. The Honble James Freisly and Robert Smith Esq. Enter the house and deliver the Honble Speaker the bill for Impost of 3. p. &c. assented to by his Excellency and Council in Assembly.

The Committee appointed for stating and Examining the publick acc. Enter the house and deliver a Journall of their proceedings. which being read was assented to by the House of Delegates and sent up to his Excellency and Council by Mr. Tho. Smith and other Gent. of that Comitted.

They returne and say they delivered the same. The Honble Thomas Tench Esq. Enter the house and deliver Mr. Speaker the bill for apportioning the publick leavy, assented to by his Excellency and Council &c.

Ordinance for building the prison as foll^o

By the House of Delegates May 17th 1701.

Resolved that Mr. Mr. Bladen by all convenient speed build and finish a prison after the same dimensions as proposed at an Assembly the 19th of July 1699. to be well and substantially built and finished on some Lott in the Towne of Annapolis as his Excellency the Gov. shall please to direct and to be paid for the same when finished two hundred and forty pounds Current Money out of the publick stock of this Province if his Excellency and Council shall please to concur therewith. and it is ordered that Mr. Saml. Young and Mr. James Saunders and Mr. John Dorsey be appointed to oversee and direct the building of the said prison according to the former dimensions agreed upon.
