by Mr. Benj^o. Hall and Mr. Phillimon Loyd.

They returned and say they delivered the bill.

The Hon^{ble} Coll: W. Hammonds and Coll: Edward Loyd entered the
house and delivered Mr. Speaker. A Bill prohibiting a band of Woods Rangers

It is moved by Mr. Thomas Beale that whereas there was a public
allowance made him in Money Sterling and according to order of
this house he had a Draught on Mr. Robert Mason then Treas^r. for
the Western Shore but for as much as the said Treasurer died before
the money paid the said Mr. Beale applied himselfe to the Executrix
of the said Mason for satisfaction but she utterly denied alledging
she had none of the publick Stock in her hands. therefore prayd Reliefe

It is therefore Ordered that Mr. Rowland Chiseldyn and George
Muschamps Esq. inspect the publick acc^{ts} of Mr. Mason and make reports
thereof if any Bal^d. soe that this house may give Mr. Beale satisfaction
and Reliefe.

Resumed his Excell^{ty} Speech and his Sacred Majesty's Speech for supply
of Money for building a Fort in the Government of New York and
lays now under debate of this house - and

Resolved that three hundred pounds Sterling be remitted and
it be signified to his Excell^{ty} by Messag^{rs}.

Maj: Walter Smith moved this house that he might have leave
to goe home being much indisposed, which was by this house
granted him and he thereupon departed.

The house adjourned till Monday Morning 7 a clock.

Dies Luna. 23^o March 1702.

The house met and were called over, and sent ason Yesterday
only Maj: Walter Smith absent having Liberty to goe home.

Serjt: Coll: Thomas Smith taken sick, Mr. Elisha Hall and Mr. John
Hall enter the house not being sent when roll called over.

The petition of Dan: Goe of Kent County thereby praying an act for
Sale of Mr. Mich^o. Milbourns Lands for payment of his debts was here read
and Resolved that for as much as ^{part} of the said Milbourns have noe
notice of this petition. Therefore the Consideracon thereof is referred to the
next Sessions of Assembly.

Coll: W. Whittington a member for Long Bottom ^{Co} enters the house and takes his place.
