Honble Councille enters the house and delivers Mr. Speaker the Bill for approoving the publick Seavy Endowed.

Assented to by his Roy. and Councille, March 25. 1702.

Signed of order W. Bladen Clk. Councille.

The same Bill was assented to by the House of Delegates.

Ed. Die of order. W. Tayland Clk. House Depts.

Mr. Phillemon Loyd and Mr. Benjamin Hall sent up to the Honble Councille with the severall proposed Bills Engesed and are ord^d to desire that they may be affixed and made ready and that this house will be ready to attend his Roy. in the afternoon or when his Roy. shall please to command them.

They returne and say they delivered their Message and so the house adjourned till two a clock in P. Afternoon. Post Merid. The house met again according to adjournment and being called over were all present as in P. Morning.

Mr. W. Bladen Clk. of his Maty. Honble Councille enters the house and informs Mr. Speaker that his Roy. Commands him and the whole house to attend him at the Councille Chamber to compleate this Session of Assembly.

At the Councille Chamber Mr. Speaker presented his Roy. the severall Bills made this Session.

To which his Roy. was pleased to give his assent thereto by endorsing them severally in these words, viz.

March 25th 1702. On behalfe of his Most Gracious Majesty King William the third &c. I will these to be Lawes.
W. Blakiston.

Which being done his Roy. was pleased to Seale them with the Broad Seale of this Province, which Lawes being soe signed and Sealed.

His Roy. was pleased to acquainte this house that he thought it convenient for his Maty. service to prorogue them untill the twenty fifth day of April next at which time if there be no occasion of their meeting he would after give them timely notice.

Thereupon Mr. Speaker and the rest of the house were prorogued accordingly.

Soe Ended the Second Session of Assembly on Wednesday the 25th day of March Anno domi 1702. and in the 14th Year of the Reigne of our Sovereigne Lord William the third by the Grace of God of England, Scotland, France and Irelands King defender of the Faith &c.
