Whereas sundry persons had money allowed them by the public for their sundry services and ord. have been drawn therefor on the public Treasurer who don't pay the payment any other way than by pieces of eight or six shillings a piece (under pretence of having no other coin) which they cannot pay away at that rate

It is represented as a great grievance and prayer the same may be settled by an Act after tamony at what rates the sundry sorts of coins of late current in this Province may pass for the future for the safe advantage of the whole Province. Being read and debated till three o'clock it is agreed and that a Bill be prepared and brought in to remedy the same by after tamony the value of such coins.
