There being severall Members wanting in the House who  
are deceased Therefore Orderd M<sup>r</sup>. Speaker Issue his warrant  
to his Majesty's Society for issuing writts for Election  
of Burgesses viz. one to Kent County for a Member to  
serve in the Room of M<sup>r</sup>. Elias King deceased and another  
to serve for Talbot County instead of M<sup>r</sup>. Henry Coursoy
