And that such Inhabitants or their families that shall kill
any Wolves and bring their head or heads to a Justice of Peace
(if required) shall make oath thereto before Certificate thereof
be granted.

The Petition of George Plater being read and considered
of was ordered to be Endors'd viz.

By the House of Delegates April 5th 1707.
Upon Reading this within petition this House have Order'd that
the Towns at Backwitts Island be again layd out and no Strains
to be left but places sett out for convenient ports, and Publick
buildings according to the direction of the Commissioners and
that the Land on the Island (after the places allotted for Publick
buildings) be laid out into 500. Lots.
