Sworn to in Council. — Bladen C. C. —

Which said severall depositions were here Read in the house and being
fully debated and Considered, the house find it relates to some high
Crimes and misdemeanors Supposed to be Committed by Mr. Joseph Hill a
Member of this House, Therefore Orderd that Mr. Joseph Hill withdraw
the House till the Matter in the Depositions be further debated.

Upon which Mr. Hill withdrew. —

And then the House did further proceed to debate the matters layd to
his Charge, and the depositions being Read and fully Considered — It
was moved by a Member that it may be putt to the Vote whether the
Crimes layd to Mr. Hill's Charge (as in the Depositions is sett forth) be
sufficient to Expell him or no.

Which being likewise debated —

It was afterwards, putt to the Question whether it be sufficient to
expell him or not Carryed in the Affirmative — Thereupon Resolved
he be dismiss and Expell'd this House till he be cleared of what is
layd to his Charge.

Upon which Mr. Hill was Call'd into the House — He Appeard
And Mr. Speaker to acquaint him with the Vote and Resolves of
the House aforesaid.

And soe withdrew.

The House Adjournes till to Morrow Morning. Seven a Clock
Saturday: the 22th April 1707. —

The House next again were Call'd over and present as
Yesterday only Mr. Hill. —

Read what was done Yesterday —

Upon Reading the Report of the Committee Appointed to inspect the
Law it was Resolved Nomine Contradictorie that the Consideration
thereof be Referr'd till next Session of Assembly — And that a Bill
shall be brought in to continue the Law.

And likewise Orderd, that this Matter come under debate of
House at the first Sitting of the next Assembly. —
