It is Resolved a Bill be brought in to prevent the Inhabitants
of the Towne of Annapolis, from keeping any other Hogs —
Horses Cattle Sheepe or Goales within the Towne Fence, than
what may be kept within fence on their own Cotts on paine
of 2: 6. & read on such as shall be found depasturing there
two houses His Excellency the Gov^r. excepted, and the Gate-
Keeper one horse, and to Receive all the fines for his Encou-
agement in providing a pound.
