Sent up to His Excellency and Council by Mr. John Hodson and Mr  
John MacLaster. —

They Returns and say they delivered the Message —

Soon after Coll Ennalls Enters the House and acquainted Mr.  
Speaker that his Excellency and Council will agree the depositions  
against W. Hill be entred in the proper place in the Journall, so that  
they be Close Sealed up not to be opened till W. Hill's tryall be over, to  
which this House Concurr'd. —

Thereupon Mr. William Bladen Clerk of the Council enters  
the House, and did in the House Close Seal up the said depositions.  
and Order'd to be affixed in the Journall —

And so Mr. Bladen Withdrew. —
