Thereupon the Speaker and the Rest of the members of the House goe up to the Council Chamber and carryed with him the severall Laws Enacted this Session being in Number four and twosy with the Address to her Majesty.

To each of which said Bills, (A List whereof is hereto Annexed) was affixd the Great Seale of this Province.

And his Excellency was pleas'd to Enact the same into Laws by underwriting thus — April 15<sup>th</sup> 1707.

On behalf of her Sacred Majesty Queen Ann &c.

I will this be a Law. John Seymour

Then his Excellency was pleas'd to say to M<sup>r</sup>. Speaker and the Members of the House of Delegates.

That with the Advice of her Majestys Honble Council he thought fitt to prorogue the House to the 14<sup>th</sup> Day of June and if not convened again before the fifth Day of September next at which time his Excellency is pleas'd to declare this Assembly will be dissolved.

Which being ended the Speaker and Members retir'd to their House M<sup>r</sup>. Speaker having taken the Chair was pleas'd to Repeat the prorogation and Orderd the Clark to Annex a List of the Laws Enacted this Session And soe departed the House.
