

Upon Reading the foregoing Report in the House: —  
 Resolv'd it's an Aggrievance and that his Excellency be Address'd to  
 Restore the Power of Admitting and Suspending Attorneys to the  
 Justices of the several Courts as formerly.

It is further Offer'd to the Committee as an Aggrievance —

That whereas Several Merchants trading into this Province —  
 through pretence of having leave from his Excellency the Govern'd.  
 has kept Stores and disposed of their Comodities out of the Townes —  
 Against the form of the Late Act of Assembly made to the Contrary,  
 and altho' Several of them have been presented by the Grand  
 Jurors at the Assizes for the same, yet the Attorney Generall of this  
 Province, has neglected to proceed thereon which has been great  
 means of discouragement of many people that would proceed in  
 Building the said Townes whereby they have lost the advantage  
 of the time given them by the said Act to build on their said  
 Lots, which cannot be recalled without the Assistance of this  
 Generall Assembly, all which is humbly referred to the Consideration  
 of the Honble House of Delegates.
