 Young Esq. on Saturday relating to Talbot County Court House  
 This House concurr with the proposall of the Honble Council and  
 Order'd that on the first Monday in April next coming M<sup>r</sup>. Matthew  
 Tilghman Ward, M<sup>r</sup>. Robert Tingle, and M<sup>r</sup>. John Dawson or any one  
 of them attend at the Town of Oxford, to take the Names of all  
 such persons Inhabitants of Talbot County qualified to Elect  
 Delegates, as are for continuing the Court house at Oxford. And  
 that M<sup>r</sup>. Thomas Robbins, M<sup>r</sup>. James Lloyd, and Doctor Bullen or  
 any one of them at the same time attend at Pitts' Bridge and take  
 names of such Inhabitants as aforesaid as are for removing the Court  
 house to the Center of Talbot County, and that they return the Lists  
 by them taken Close sealed up under their hands to this House the next  
 Session of Assembly for consideration —
