not Satisfied with the Votes as aforesaid therefore Resolved that the
following Question be putt to the House, whether the aforesaying
Vote be Reasum'd or Not

Which was Carryed in the Negative
And Resolved the Court house be Settled and Continued at
Oxford Towne pursuant to an Act of Assembly made for that
purpose.
