

November 15th 1709 — Read in the House of Delegates — and they concurred therewith. Signed J. order W. Sayland (Att. Gen.) W. Daniel Marriar to and Cap. Richard Jones Order to attend the Honble Council and acquaint them that this House have nothing left before them therefore are ready to wait on their Honors when commanded to conclude this Session —

They returns and say they deliver'd their Messages The Honble Coll Holland and Coll Coursey enter the House — and acquaint W. Speaker that the Honble Presid. and Council commands him and the whole House to attend them at the Council Chamber and so withdrew

Upon which the House adjourned to the Council Chamber and W. Speaker carried with him the following Engrossed Bills

- 14 Bill revising the Act for the Militia &c
- 15 Bill relating to runaways Imprisonment and for Relief of Indian Harry
