The House met according to Adjournment being called over
were present as on Saturday but W. Lee Cap^t. Jones and W.
Tyler absent and W. Homely Sick.

Magdalen Edmonsons petition being Read, and the Council
on both sides heard and orderd to withdraw — the matter in
the petition being debated It's Resolv'd the petition be rejected
Upon Reading Cap^t. Jacob Howards bond for payment of three
pounds of Gold for Rum &c was Orderd to be indors'd as follows —
viz^t By the House of Delegates 30th October 1750

It's Resolv'd that Tho: Jones was not such an Inhabitant as
would Excuse the payment of the Duty but that he ought to
pay the same — Signed & orderd R. Dallam C^t J. D. S.

W. Thomas Frisby and W. Mathias Vanderheyden Members
for Cecil enter the House and took their places

W. Tyler enters the House
Mov'd that a Bill be brought in to settle Baltimore County
Court House at the Towne of Joppa

Put to the Question whether it shall be decided by the Freehold
or Not — Carry'd in the Affirmative and Resolv'd that the
Justices of Baltimore County Court at their next Court give notice
that the Freeholders meet at their old Court House next March
Court and that W. Richard Clegale take the Votes of all the
Freehold that are for removing the Court House from Joppa
and W. Aquila Pace take the Votes of all that are for continu-
ing the Court house there, and the Sheriff attend them if so
require — and either of those Gentlemen to administer Oath
on occasion require and make report of their proceedings to the
House the next Session of Assembly

W. Richard Bennetts petⁿ Referred to the next Session was
Read and further Referred to next Session &c.

W. Jos: Hills petⁿ praying an Allowance of a Debt of
two pounds one Shilling in Money due to his father from the
Country and assigned him by one Tanagerzall attorney for
German being the Ballance due for finishing the same
Read and Consider'd — It's Resolv'd that the said Jos: Hill be
allowed the same in Current money and Recommended to the
Committee of Accounts for that purpose
