The Bill proposed for regulating proceedings at Law and preventing
 Multiplicity of Actions in the Provinciall Court of this Province
 has been read att this Board, and we assure you we have very hearty
 inclinations to relieve the unhappy State of poor distressed debtors —
 in this Province, as much as it lies; But being indisposiblly —
 tyed to a strict observance of Her Majestys instructions, we hope and
 desire you will not insist upon the Bill as now proposed from your
 Hon^s, But that you will some other wayes as effectually provide
 a sufficient remedy to the Aggrevance the Country now lies under and
 as to the other matters in your Bill proposed either refer till an
 other Session or by a separate Law provide redress thereto —
