This House have considered the Message and Bill proposed by your Honor for Relieving the Aggravances complained off and rather than run into further debates about it, (tho' they think the Bill proposed by this House came nearer to the matter) have so far concurred to your Honor's request that they now hope all obstacles are removed, and that nothing will any longer impede your Assent to the Bill herewith sent, but that the same will meet with quick dispatch, and confirm in us the good inclinations, you are pleased to declare, you have to relieve the unhappy State of this poor distressed Province which never wanted it more then now, and as this House never had any intent or designs to retrench for Majesty's Royall prerogative, for they will to their utmost always support and maintain the same, Signed Order Rich^d Dallam (S^r D^r)
