The Presidents Speech again Read, It is Resolved Mr Wornell Hunt and Mr George Gabe be a Committee to consider thereof and prepare an Address answer thereto and lay the Same before the House to Morrow Morning.

The House proceed to settle the following Committee viz^t Cap. James Phillips, Mr Jos. Hill, Mr John Bradford and Mr Thomas Bordley be and are appointed a Committee for Stating the Publick Accounts

Mr Robert Tyler, Mr John Whittington, and Mr John Mackall are appointed a Committee to hear the Aggravances of the Province

Mr Thomas Smithson, Mr Job. Gabe, Mr John West, Col Low and Mr Worthington, be and are appointed a Committee of Laws

Mr Richard Jones, Mr Daniel Marriates, and Mr Robert Ungles are appointed a Committee for Election and priviledges.

Mr Henry ward a Member Returned for Coll County attended the House, And Order'd that Mr Mathias Vander Wyden and Mr John West, attend him to the Council to see him Sworn in

They returns and say they saw him qualified and thereupon the said Mr Ward, took his place in the House
