By the House of Delegates October 30<sup>th</sup> 1711

This House have consider'd and debated the Message  
and instructions relating to the sealing the Copies of the Laws  
sent to Great Britain and cannot for any reason be induc'd  
them to recede from their former Resolves of paying but for two  
Seals every Session and that only for the publick Acts, and  
as for Seals to the private Acts, have Resolv'd the publick  
ought not to pay for any Seals but the person in whose  
favour such private Acts pass ought to pay the same

We have likewise consider'd and debated the Message  
relating to building Houses for Magazines in every County  
and have resolv'd upon the Question putt that such houses are  
not necessary or convenient to be built, but that they will the  
next Session of Assembly consider of some means to provide  
the Arms and Ammunition &c.
