Subjects there for very small sums, and to arrest persons out
of the County where they live, and during the Sessing and
Sitting of the prov^e Court being induced thereto as your p^r Es^t B^r by
the favour as they expect from such persons as are in the
said Courts, as well Judiciall as Ministeriall Officers which your
Pet^rs conceive is a great Aggrievance and Oppression to her Majes-
tys poor Subjects, who groan under the burthen of debt and
Oppression of mercifles Editors and Avaritious Attorneys and
other officers, and they Humbly pray your Hono^r to reprobate
it as an Aggrievance to the Hon^{ble} House of Delegates, And
Humbly Beg their Hono^r will find some expedient to prevent
the like for the future either by inhibiting any person that recies
any profits in the Courts to be a Judge ther^e, and oblige the
said Courts, Ex Officio to abate all procs and proceedings ther^e
brought or to be brought against the intent of the same
