The House met according to Adjournment being called over were present as yesterday except Mr Vandheyden who is sick —

The Gent^{ls} appointed to agree with Mr Edwards to the quarter part of the Lot No 37. Report that Mr Edwards offer'd four pounds for a Fee simple, Mr Edwards appear'd in the House and agreed to pay four pounds therefore and to pay the Charges of the Act —
 Resolv^d the Committee of Laws draw a Bill to confirm the same to him —

Ordered Mr Cadwallader Edwards make good and sufficient window shutters for all the windows in the State House where wanting and lay his Accounts thereof before this House, for which he shall be paid by the publick —

Bill relating to poor debtors, Read with the Councils and debated and ordered to be indors^d —

By the House of Delegates 31st October 1711 —

The House concur with the Hon^{ble} Councils opinion that whatsoever has been done in pursuance of the former Law and until such time as her Majestys disassent thereto published here was & is well done and ought not to be disputed in any Court of Judicature — but considering the different opinion of the Judiciary think this Bill highly necessary and at the request of the Hon^{ble} Councill will not at present further proceed therein but leave the consideration
