They returns and say they saw him qualified Mr John Rowsey, Naval Officer for the District of Patuxent being called into the House produces his accounts to Mr Speaker

And Ordered Mr Hunt and Mr Hudson attend him to his Excellency and Council to see him sworn thereto and thereupon withdrew

The House Adjourns till to Morrow Morning Eight a Clock Wednesday Septemb^r. 29th 1708.

The House met according to Adjournment and being called over were present as yesterday

Mr Hunt and Mr Hudson acquaint the House they have seen Mr Rowsey Sworn to his Naval Officers accounts before his Excellency and Council pursuant to the Order of yesterday

The former Rules of this House being Read is Ordered to be Transcribed and Affixed in some publick place of the House that the Membrs thereof may have recourse thereto and conform themselves to them that they be duly observed during this Session

Mr John Hynson a Member Elected for Coll County being Dead Resolved that the Speaker of this House issue his Warrant to her Majesty's Principall Secretary of State of this Province or his Deputy to issue a new writt for Election of another Member in his stead returnable forthwith which accordingly Issue and is as followeth Viz

Your humbley required on Receipt thereof to Issue her Majesty's Writt of Election to the Sheriff of Coll County to Elect and Choose a Delegate or Representative to serve for the said County in this present Assembly in the Rooms of Mr John Hynson deceased returnable forthwith, and for your soe doing, this shall be your sufficient Warrant Given under my hand the 29th Day of Septemb^r. 1708
