The Members being returned to their own House Mr Tyler thanked them for their good opinion of him and that the Honble President at his request had given them leave to consider further of their Speaker and earnestly desired them to be excused recommending Mr Robert Ungle a Member returned for Talbot County as a more capable person

Several Members of her Majesty's Honble Council enter the House and their Clerks there Read her Majestys writt of Prorogation in these words. Viz.

Maryland Is

ANNE by the Grace of God of Great Britain France and Ireland Queen Defender of the faith To our Trusty and well beloved our Councillors and the Delegates and Burgesses elected to serve in our generall Assembly of this our Province of Maryland convened as on this day greeting, Know yee that we have thought fitt and doe hereby prorogue the said Generall Assembly untill Wednesday the twentieth instant; At which ^{time} we will you to convene your selves together at the City of Annapolis in order to consult debate advise and consent to such things as by the favour of Almighty God shall then and there happen to be ordained and Enacted to the Glory of God Her Majestys Honour and the welfare of this Province, Witness my self at the City of Annapolis this twenty Eighth Day of October in the Eleventh year of our Reigne. 6th Anno^q Dni 1712
