

Bill reviewing the Act for reviewing some Approvements

 Bills pass'd in the Assembly held in Novemb^r 1709 were not pass'd
 according to her Royal instructions in that they were said
 only to be Enacted by and with the Advice and consent of the
 Council and Assembly, and not the President Council and
 Assembly, and therefore having declared them not Enacted by
 a sufficient Authority, and this Bill aiming to revive an other
 Enacted in the same manner it will be contrary to what her
 Majesty has been pleas'd to signify to us and of some effect.

And for as much as the said Bill curtails the Jurisdiction of
 her Majesty's Courts we cannot think it safe for us at this time to
 re-enact such a Law, But when a Govern^r in Chief comes fully
 instructed we shall readily joyn with you in representing to him
 what may be for the benefit and advantage of the Province.
