They returns and say they deliver'd their Message Upon the Report of Mr^s Tyler from the Committee of Aggravances Resolv'd that a Bill be brought in to empower the Sheriffs upon receipt of any writs of fieri facias or Attachment to swear two indifferent persons who are neither of kin to the pl^t or defend^t to Appraise the goods seized and if no buyers offer in a little time to deliver them at such Appraisment to the Creditors in satisfaction of the debt and to oblige the Creditors to accept the same which will prevent the Ruine of many mens Estates, especially such as are in the hands of Executors or Administrators

Also Resolv'd upon the Report from the said Committee That a Bill be brought in to prevent the dilatory proceedings as well in the provinciall as the County Courts, by obliging the practitioners and others to be ready for Tryall and to allow any person that will to take out writs in their own names and to confess Judgm^t in their own proper persons and that no Attorney demand or receive his fee before the final end of the cause he is retain'd in

Mr^s Tyler also Reports from the said Committee an Aggravance relating to the Gauge of Tobacco Hogshoads — Read and Resolv'd it be consider'd of to Morrow morning in a full House

The papers brought into the House relating to Baltimore County Court House — Read and debated Mr^s Rich^d Cogatt and Mr^s Wm^s Talbott and severall Gent^l of that County having leave appear'd in the House, and were heard therein and being withdrawn the House Nomine Contradiants — Resolv'd that a Bill be brought in to settle the Court of that County at the Town of Joppa in the new Court House there built, and for settling that Court house on the County and to continue all process and proceedings of that Court.

Resolv'd Coll Maxwell lay before this House the Agreement made with the Justices of Baltimore County for building the Court House
