

In the Council in Assembly Novemb^r 30th 1754
 In Answer to your Message by Cap^t Jones and M^r Cunnalls of the
 Sixth instant relating to the Naval Office and papers therein desired
 to be lodged in the Council Office, we cannot be assured that the
 same before (tho' now it is so) will always hold both Offices so that
 it may be unfit the Naval Officer should have recourse to the
 Council Office, but are rather inclined that the Office appointed for
 the Town Court be allotted to the Clerks of your House, and that the
 Assembly Office should be to the Town Clerks of the City of Annapolis
 in lieu thereof, and desiring you will send a Member or two from your
 House with these Gents. from our Board to view the said Offices
 and concert that matter — Signed J. Gordon W. Bladen & C^o.
 Upon Reading this Message the House concurred therewith and M^r.
 James Lloyd, and M^r. Daniel Marriartes Order'd to attend the Gents
 of her Majesty's Honble Council to view the Offices —

The said Gents. report they have view'd the Offices and find that
 the Town Office is very convenient but wants furnishing wth Table
 Desks &c. Resolved that the Town Office be now appointed
 for the Clerks of this House and that the same be fitted up as the
 Council Office now is and that the Office called the Assembly Office
 belong to the Town Clerks of the City of Annapolis according to the
 Message from the Council;

Resolved a Supplementary Act be brought in to the Act
 for probatt of Wills to oblige Creditors to take the oaths &c. good
 at the Appraisment.
