publick Treasurer to take the Gold received by the Navall Officer but as
to taking a side that Officer he being appointed by Law we cannot consent
thereto especially if he gives good security for his Office and notwithstanding
the order of our Navall Officer to bring the money to Annapolis and
pay it unto such person to whom the same shall be Orderd by the
Committee for Accounting the publick Levy the rest of the Navall
Officers may not be willing thereto we do not know of any Security
given by the Treasurers or either the Eastern or Western Shore
the discharge of their Office. Signed Order W^m Bladen & C.
