 already. That the Money now in the Treasurers hands belonging to the
 Greeschools be Call'd in and let out on good Land Security to such
 persons as will take the same at a reasonable Interest not for less
 than four years and a years notice to pay or Call in the same that
 the Treasurers pay so much of the Money as they have received in
 bills of Exchange or money Store in the same Species they And.
