M^r Tyler from the Committee of Grievances enters the House and delivers
M^r Speaker the following Report viz^t By the Committee of Grievances
November 5th 1753 - It is humbly offered to this Committee as an Grievance
that the bounds of severall parishes ⁱⁿ severall Counties within this
Province are uncertain that it ^{has} caused severall disputes between the
Parishoners and Incumbent of the said parishes they being not bounded
by Natural bounds or otherwise which might be prevented if the Justices
of each County or the Major part of them had power given them to
determine such disputes as aforesaid by ascertaining the bounds
of such parishes for the future and cause their proceedings therein
to be entered on their County records all which is referred to the
House consideration of the House. — And it is further offered to

this Committee as an Grievance that whereas there has been severall
disputes arose between the Tithy and incumbent that is inducted into any
parish some considerable time after the Laying the County Levy or
such incumbent that shall remove himself before his year is completed
what part of the forty shillings belongs to him that is inducted as a
or him that removes as aforesaid for that year there being no
law to ascertain the same all which is referred to the consideration
