 In Answer to your Message by Coll Mackall and Nine others we have appoy-  
 nted the Honble Coll Holland. Sam<sup>l</sup> Young Esq. Coll Thomas Addison  
 Philimon Loyd Esq. and Coll Richard Tilghman to Joyn with the  
 Members of the House of Delegates on the Conference this Day agreed to  
 and to meet immediately at M<sup>r</sup> Doods. Signed J. Beale Secy. & C. Secy.  
 Whereupon the Conference withdrew, the House adjourned for an hour  
 The House next according to Adjournment. The Report from the Conference  
 this Day hold at M<sup>r</sup> Doods viz. brought into the House and is as follows

 Who make choice of Coll W<sup>m</sup>. Holland Chairman and John Beale their Clerk  
 and her Majesty's Order in Council in relation to passing the Law aforesaid  
 being first read the Honble Council appointed upon the Conference propose to  
 the Conference of the Honble House of Delegates that there be a Law made for  
 Regulating Ordinary and Appropriating the fines thereof to her Majesty's  
 Secretary of the Province of Maryland for the time being pursuant to her said  
 Majesty's Order in Council aforesaid and Offer their Reasons therefor which  
 being fully debated the said Conference of the House of Delegates could not agree  
 thereto believing that the Secretary has no right to the same. Whereupon the  
 said Conference being ended they withdrew to their several places. Signed J.  
 Beale Secy. The House adjourns till to Morrow Morning 7 o'clock  
 Saturday Nov<sup>r</sup> 14. 1713. The House according to Adjournment mett  
 being called over were present as yesterday. Read what was done yesterday
